Care after breast cancer shouldn't end with treatment. The need for women to receive support after finishing hospital treatment continues but too many women do not receive the professional support that is required to manage the long-term effects of the disease.

There is much more that needs to be done to ensure that the almost 700,000 women living with breast cancer in the UK can access tailored support to meet their needs.
