On March 28th, the House of Commons held an important debate in which ministers discussed the future of Beer Taxation and Pubs. Pubs play an important role in many of our communities, contributing substantially to the British economy and providing employment to almost 1 million people. The debate called for cuts to beer duty in future Budgets, reform business rates and continue to look at new ways of reducing the disproportionate tax burden on pubs and breweries.
